GENERAL INFORMATION

for Parents/Guardians/Caretakers

You are welcome be on the property during your child's session or you may leave during a class time but must be back before the end of class.

We hope for this time to be relaxing and enjoyable for all who come. Here are some ideas for that time, as well as some general safety rules:

- Seek out one of the many private benches on the ranch for quiet reflection and prayer, reading or visiting.
- Get plugged in as a Local Volunteer.
- Play or be involved with your kids who are not in sessions/class. Please keep these children with you at all times. You are welcome to use our kid corral (sand box) during your stay.
- Please do not chase the chickens or try to pick up without a DHR Leader with you.
- Watch your children ride during their session/class. We do ask that you watch from a distance and help us to maintain a one-on-one relationship with your child.
- Taking pictures is permitted and encouraged. Again, we ask parents to use discernment regarding giving space to their child and leader during the session/class.
- The horses love to welcome visitors. We invite you to meet them over the fence. However, please do not enter the paddocks or feed any treats without a DHR leader present.
- **PLEASE –PLEASE – PLEASE** do not speed on Haven drive or down our driveway-we have many animals-kids and equipment on our property! Even if you are late!!!!

Clothing & Equipment Requirements & Recommendations

- Shoes/boots with closed toes, with little or no tread and a heel are recommended (often we have extras on hand, so let us know if you don't have this type of shoe/boot).
- Long pants are recommended for riding.(preferably jeans)
- Nothing is permitted to be hanging down around the neck or tied around the waist while riding.
- To promote individual responsibility, we recommend that kids bring their own water bottle and sunscreen.
